

Kids Have Strokes Too!
Stroke has no age limits. It can happen to children, even infants.

- Warning Signs in Children:
- Remember: No righty/lefty before 18 months of age so watch for favoring one hand
- Holding the other hand in a fist
- Weakness on one side
- Delays in rolling, sitting, crawling and walking
- Sudden severe headache, especially with vomiting and sleepiness
- Sudden numbness or weakness on one side of the body (face, arm and/or leg)
- Sudden confusion, difficulty speaking or understanding others
- Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- Sudden difficulty walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- New onset of seizures, usually on one side of the body
